1. How Infectious Diseases Are Transmitted	Clearly and correctly summarizes 3 or more ways infectious diseases can be transmitted, including examples of both direct and indirect contact.	Correctly summarizes 2 ways infectious diseases can be transmitted, including examples of both direct and indirect contact.	Correctly summarizes 1 way infectious diseases can be transmitted, but includes examples of only direct or indirect contact, not both.	Does not correctly summarize ways infectious diseases can be transmitted.
2. How Food-Borne Diseases Are Transmitted	Clearly and correctly describes 3 or more ways common food-borne diseases can be transmitted.	Clearly and correctly describes 2 ways common food-borne diseases can be transmitted.	Clearly and correctly describes 1 way common food-borne diseases can be transmitted.	Does not correctly describe ways common food-borne diseases can be transmitted.
3. Relationship Between Injection Drug Use and Blood-Borne Diseases	Clearly and correctly describes how injection drug use can transmit blood-borne diseases when blood from an infected person is left on the needle or other equipment, and explains that HIV and/or hepatitis B and C can be passed in this way.	Correctly describes how injection drug use can transmit blood-borne diseases if blood from an infected person is left on the needle or other equipment, without providing an example.	States that injection drug use can transmit blood-borne diseases without explaining how. OR Gives an example of a disease that can be transmitted through blood, but doesn't explain how this can happen.	Does not correctly explain that injection drug use can transmit infectious diseases that are blood borne.
4. Ways to Prevent the Spread of Infectious Disease	Clearly and correctly describes 4 or more ways to prevent the spread of infectious disease.	Clearly and correctly describes 2 or 3 ways to prevent the spread of infectious disease.	Correctly describes 1 way to prevent infectious disease.	Does not correctly describe ways to prevent infectious disease.

Scale: **4** = Exceeds expectations **3** = Meets expectations **2** = Mostly meets expectations **1** = Does not meet expectations
